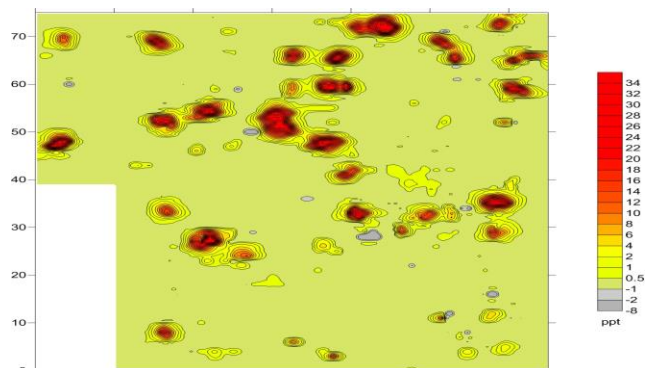


Hello, my name is Benjamin Foote. I am a late addition to our summer staff, but I am still equally excited about this job. Currently I am a grade 11 student at Park

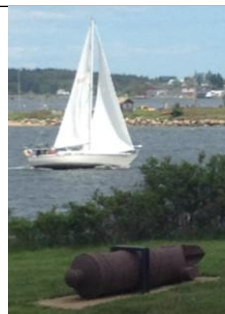


Congratulations to Graduates!
